



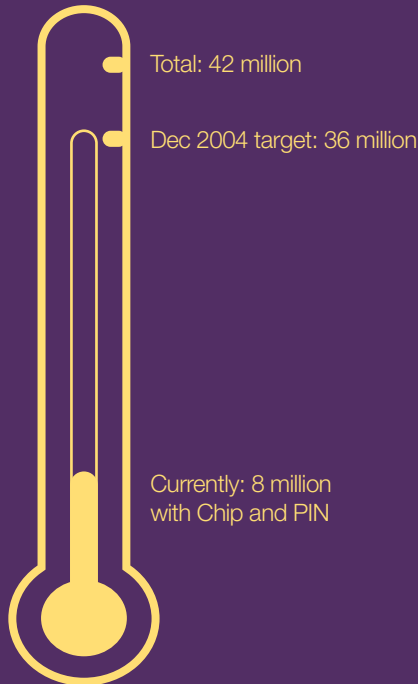
# Chip and PIN barometer

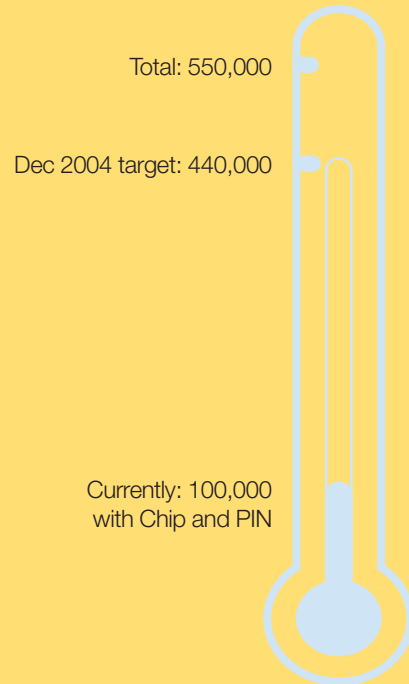
## UK cardholders

(total number of people who hold at least one credit or debit card)



## Small/medium-sized retailers

(typically those with bank-owned terminals)



## Large retailers

(who typically own their own terminals)

- Large retailers account for 70% of all card payments - half of these will be chip and PIN by 2005
- There are over 100,000 chip and PIN transactions in Safeway per week
- Safeway expect to save over 13,000 miles of till receipts following the introduction of chip and PIN.

## Did you know?

- Around one in six cardholders in the UK already have a chip and PIN card
- Over 50 card issuers will be issuing new chip and PIN cards
- Fraud losses between June 02 and June 03 topped £411 million
- There were over 167,000 transactions in Northampton during the chip and PIN trial
